

1 Peter 2:1-10
Lesson Three

Through the life, death and resurrection of his Son, Jesus, God removed the barriers between Him and His people to become unified with them. As Peter explains, followers of Jesus have become the temple of God's presence. Joining all of them together with the mortar of his Spirit, the master builder places each person, each "living stone," so that together we form a magnificent temple to house God's glory.
